Instructional Checklist for each lecture period

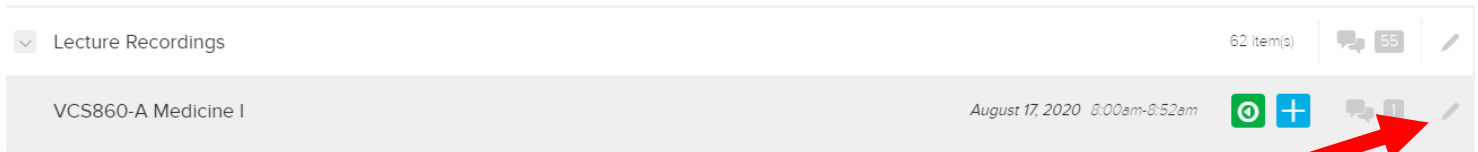
1. Go into the BI Auditorium to provide your lecture. Zoom and Echo360 should be set-up to be LIVE and record your lecture into Echo360
